The South Lake Tahoe Women's Center is the only provider of domestic violence and sexual assault services from South Lake Tahoe west to Placerville, north to Incline Village, and east to Carson Valley – and is the only provider in all of Alpine County.

The Women's Center provides most of its services in the business office building. Generous local support allowed the agency to move into this facility in 1999.

Women's Center Services

- ⌘ Batterers Intervention and Treatment for men and women
- ⌘ Anger Management for teen boys
